# **NOTICE TO HOME PLACE DISTRICT RESIDENTS REGARDING ANNEXATION**

You may not be aware of the recent court ruling in favor of Carmel proceeding with annexation of the Home Place district. This decision followed the decision by Carmel to continue their efforts to forcibly annex our community after a 3 year hiatus initiated in 2013 by Concerned Citizens for Home Place, a not for profit community organization that has been protecting and organizing against this forced annexation since 2004.

We have one more opportunity to contest Carmel's aggression and it will require your help and participation. Failing to answer this call will result in the annexation proceeding, risking the influence, taxation, and debt of the City of Carmel to fall upon our community. Join us to discuss....
